- Creating a network of learning and sharing
























#### Participating in SHN

TAKE YOUR INFECTION PREVENTION & CONTROL EFFORTS TO THE NEXT LEVEL







- **AIM:** help teams accelerate the implementation of evidence based strategies, such as hand hygiene, environmental cleaning and surveillance, to reduce healthcare associated infections
- Who: any team, from any sector of care who wants to work towards reducing infections
- What: a 12 + 6 month virtual collabortive with: 7 virtual learning sessions over a 12-month period, with monthly support calls and ongoing team support for 6-additional months
- When: starts November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011
