United States: Nevada

Pamlico

- District scale volcanic hosted high-grade gold discovery at the intersection of prolific geological trends
- Newly staked claims add potential for sediment hosted mineralization
- Exceptional infrastructure, jurisdiction & regulatory environment

South America: Colombia

Yarumalito

- Large gold dominant porphyry and high-grade vein system both with multimillion ounce potential
- Amenable to heap leaching

El Dovio

- Gold rich, polymetallic discovery
- Amenable to conventional flotation

☐ Geologic Setting:

- District scale potential at intersecting Walker Lane and Pancake Range lineaments
- Volcanic hosted epithermal gold system in west central Nevada
- Mineralization developed along deep seated structural corridors in highly favorable volcanic rocks

Phase I RC Drilling

Sampling the Merritt Decline



- >80 meters, continuous interval (diamond saw cut)
- Composite avg.: 75.5 meters @ 2.92 g/T Au
- ► High-grade: 13.8 meters @ 17.25 g/T Au





PHASE I DRILL PROGRAM

- Exploration results confirm the high-grade gold surrounded by (halo) gold mineralization
- Identified bulk mineral potential surrounding high grade cores
- Phase I highlights:
 - Established continuity of mineralization sampled in Merritt decline
 - Discovered unknown high-grade gold zone (DH 8 and 10)
 - Multiple high-grade shallow drill intersections, including:
 - DH P17-10: 6.1 m of 98 g/T Au (incl. 1.5 m of 341 g/T Au)
 - DH P17-17: 4.6 m of 44 g/T Au (incl. 0.8 m of 244 g/T Au)
 - DH P17-08: 9.1 m of 28 g/T Au (incl. 1.5 m of 85 g/T Au)

PAMLICO PROJECT UNLOCKING EXCEPTIONAL POTENTIAL



Near term value catalysts

- > Pending drill results and property wide geophysical surveys results
- Potential to identify multiple « stacked » favorable horizons in multiple large target areas on property.
- > Potential to quickly define a high-grade gold resource in the Merritt area

Long term « blue sky » potential

- Less than 1% of property explored or drilled.
- Multiple high-grade volcanic hosted targets identified
- Sediment hosted « Carlin type » mineralization potential
- Is Pamlico the next big gold discovery in Nevada?
